- Increasing access to a wider range of experiences.

How the funding will be spent 2016-17

- To continue to provide a high level of additional adult support across the whole school to ensure personalised learning and to continue to close the gap between all groups of children in Reading, Writing and Maths.
- To continue to offer Intervention programmes before the start of the school day.
- To purchase specific resources for the intervention programmes.
- To contribute to The Centre to support children with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties both on-site and off-site. (Delivery of Be-spoke programmes to match need in our school.)
- To train key staff in delivery of therapeutic programmes.
- To provide specialist behaviour support in school.
- Contribute to peripatetic music lessons.
- Contribute to curriculum enrichment activities.
- Contribute to After school Clubs.
- Contribute to Educational Visits.
