#### **Aims of PPG Spending 2017-18**

- Raise attainment and improve rates of progress in Reading, Writing and Maths.
- Maintain staffing levels to support interventions and meet needs of pupils.
- Invest in high quality training for all staff to improve teaching and learning and secure progress.
- Purchase appropriate resources to meet needs of all pupils.
- Develop emotional well-being, social skills and behaviour of pupils.
- Increase access to a wider range of experiences. (curriculum and after-school)

#### **2017-18 PPG Funding: Areas targeted**

- continue to provide a high level of additional adult support across the whole school to ensure personalised learning and to continue to close the gap between all groups of children in Reading, Writing and Maths.
- Purchase specific resources for the intervention programmes.
- Continue to develop expertise of all staff in delivery of phonics programme and reciprocal reading.
- Train key staff in delivery of therapeutic programmes.
- Contribute to The Centre to support children with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties both on-site and off-site. (Delivery of Be-spoke programmes to match need in our school.)
- Provide specialist support in school when appropriate (Behaviour support, Cognition & Learning).
- Increase access to a wider range of curriculum enrichment experiences.
- Contribute to peripatetic music lessons.
- Contribute to After School Clubs.
- Contribute to Educational Visits.

#### **Measuring the impact of PPG Funding 2017-18**

##### KS2

- Outcomes for PP chdn are positive for all subjects at EXS & HS (except Maths)
- Progress rates for PP chdn: improving from 2017 in Reading 3.5 comp to -0.7. VA for writing remains the same. Decline in Maths from 2017.

##### KS1

- PP made progress considering starting points on entry to KS1.
- Attainment in Maths better than in reading and writing with 25% PP pupils at expected standard.

##### YEAR 1 PHONICS

- 100% Pupil Premium achieved standard.

##### EYFS

- 100% pupils achieved GLD
