Route 1 - Start 08:30 -WINNERS WALK

Begin at entrance to Bridleway on Etherley Moor (B6282) just past mini roundabout.

Stop 1 08:35 - At Bridleway junction (see map)

Stop 2 08:45 - Three Lane Ends road - meet and join Route 2

Stop 3 08:50 - Arrive at School

Route 2 - Start 08:25

Begin at Escomb Saxon Church. From Church, cross the road (take left path) and walk up Hallimond Road.

Stop 1 08:28 - At entrance to Vicarage Farm Close

Stop 2 08:33 - Bus stop on Railway bridge opposite Community Centre

Stop 3 08:45 - Three Lane Ends road - route 1 will join

Stop 4 08:50 - Arrive at School
