On Monday 9th March Thrills and Skills for Life worked with Year 2 children on a mock United Nation's flood rescue mission based in Tanzania. Children and staff thoroughly enjoyed this experience and worked as teams to complete the task. This is part of their Learning Challenge Project for this term.

Year 6 children attended the Safety Carousel which was ran by the Fire and Rescue Team. Children learned about various safety issues that they need to be aware of including water, fire, road, electricity and gas safety. There was also a workshop on online safety and the seriousness of Cyberbullying.

There was some joint work on the Easter story. All three performances were engaging and informative and reflected the learning that has been taking place in the classroom.
