

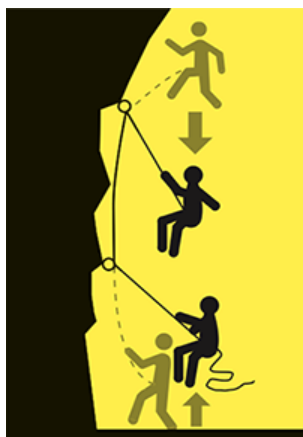


On Monday 8th February we celebrated the start of Chinese New Year with a whole school assembly.
