What is the volume of sound? - BBC Bitesize

Carry out an investigation to see how the size of a vibration affects the volume.

You will need:

- Rice
- Cling film
- Bowl

Cover the bowl tightly with the clingfilm and place a small amount of rice on top. Explore with hitting the drum gently and harder. Watch what happens to the rice and listen to the sound.

What do you notice about the relationship between how hard you hit it and the volume/vibration of the rice?

Write an explanation that includes diagrams to show this.

You are going to explore how you can make different pitches. You will need cling film and bowls of different sizes.

- 1. Wrap the cling film over the bowls tightly and bang on them. What do you notice about the relationship betwee the size of the drum and the pitch?
- Choose one bowl and change the cling film so that it is looser. Bang on the drum and listen to the sound? Not tighten it and repeat this process. What do you notice about the relationship between the tightness of the cling film and the pitch.

Create a poster that explains the how pitch is created.
